
The Next Home By Habitat: Banning CA



Habitat for Humanity Homeowner Makes Sparks Fly in 2022

In 2010 Stacey Matthews was selected to own a Habitat home; it was her first home. She completed 200 hours of sweat equity, required of new homeowners, working alongside Habitat volunteers. Stacey was excited to move into her new home in November 2011 and was elated to pay off her mortgage in February 2022.

On Friday, April 29, 2022, Habitat for Humanity San Gorgonio Pass Area hosted a mortgage burning party for homeowner Stacey Matthews. Mortgage burning parties were common in the twentieth century when most mortgage payment periods were seven to ten years. Homeowners invited family and friends to share in this significant event, burning a copy of their mortgage note representing their financial freedom and accomplishment.

Habitat Board President Amy Minjares welcomed attendees to Stacey's mortgage burning and Pastor Scott Mason led the opening prayer. President Amy invited Stacey up to the podium to burn her mortgage. Art Welch, Mickey Valdivia, and Michael Bailey followed the mortgage burning, presenting Stacey with certificates recognizing her accomplishment. President Amy closed the ceremony congratulating Stacey for completing this significant milestone and invited everyone to join Stacey in the Habitat office for refreshments.
